



# *Beyond Addictions*

In-home Detoxification & Innovative Recovery Services

**We invite you to consider working with us in the first In-home and In-hotel Detoxification Program for alcohol and drug treatment. The Program provides around-the-clock care by Registered Nurses during the detoxification process.**

**Why is Beyond Addictions the first to provide In-home and In-hotel Detoxification Program?** Last September, two Nurse Practitioners came to No Worries In-home Care with the idea that they could combine their detoxification expertise with the In-home expertise of No Worries. Typically, detoxification occurs in an inpatient setting or on an outpatient basis. Now that In-home Care has grown and advanced, it is possible to provide this new option.

**What is In-home or In-hotel detoxification?** A 3-5 day process of safely using medications to assist in the initial withdrawal. We anticipate some clients will be coming from out-of-town for this service and detoxification would occur in a hotel.

**What would I be doing?** Either 8- or 12-hour shifts with duties ranging from assessment, medication administration, assistance with meals and personal care (if needed) and accompanying the client to counseling or other appointments.

**What training would I receive?** Approximately 30 hours of paid training before providing services. We project in the future to start a CADC I (Chemical and Alcohol Dependency Counselor) training for interested Registered Nurses. A Nursing Supervisor will accompany you to your first client and assist with any additional training. A Nursing Supervisor will always go out at initiation of service and do the first assessment and set-up the Home Care Service Plan. Subsequent shifts would get reports from the Nursing Supervisor by phone and then be oriented at the home or hotel by the Nurse already providing care. A Nursing Supervisor, Nurse Practitioner, Counselor and Physician are always available to support the detoxification. As this is a new program, admission criteria have been developed to screen for safe detoxification in the home. No one with a history of seizures, medical or psychological problems that may be exacerbated by withdrawal will be included in this program.

**How much would I be paid?** Beyond Addictions will contract with No Worries In-home Care for Registered Nurse services in an effort to provide the best benefits. No Worries has been in business for 10 years and has Kaiser Healthcare, Dental, Retirement, Life Insurance, and Paid Time Off for staff working full-time (36 hours a week). Full-time and Part-time positions are available. Beyond Addictions will be starting services on February 1<sup>st</sup>. Starting wage is \$26/hour.
